Congratulations to parishioner, Anthony A. Warga, who will receive his "EAGLE SCOUT" award at a Court of Honor Ceremony, Saturday, March 30th, at 11am at the Redeemer Lutheran Church, 203 Eyland Avenue, Succasunna, NJ.

The Eagle Scout Award is the highest award a young man can earn in Boy Scouting. For his Eagle Service Project, Anthony planned and lead the execution of a capital improvement project at the Interfaith Food Pantry of the Morris County annex distribution center in Morristown. He supervised the cleaning of the facility and improved the flow of the food distribution process by building a produce and bakery display unit. He added recipe racks that help clients fully utilize the products they obtain from the pantry, plus information bulletin boards and a new entry sign. Anthony also donated \$500 to the pantry which remained from the money he had raised to fund his project. The money was collected through a fundraiser here at Resurrection Parish, as well as from family and friends.
