Samaritan \$crip shopping cards are being sold this weekend. There are over 600 retailers to choose from (check out www.shopwithscrip.com for the current list). We usually have \$100 & \$25 Shop Rite and \$100 & \$25 Acme, along with Dunkin Donuts and Panera in inventory. As always, hard copy order forms will be available at the table.

You may now enroll directly with the \$crip provider as a Resurrection member, via www.shopwithscrip.com which allows you to order online at your convenience. Stop by the table or email Tom Roche (see below) to obtain Resurrection's enrollment code. If you want the convenience of online ordering, please be sure to sign up for the Presto Pay option also, in order to pay for online orders via direct debit. Getting you set up for Presto Pay requires a day or two processing validation; but once that's done, you will be set moving forward. No more checkbooks needed coming to Mass! Your cards will be ready for pickup after Masses just as they are for those who use a paper order form.

MINISTRY TO THE SICK AND HOMEBOUND

The parable of the sower in today's Gospel gives us the opportunity to look at ourselves and see the times we have heard the message of God but didn't apply it to the circumstances of our life, as well as the times we have followed God's Word. The choices we make in any given circumstance of our life, if God centered, will allow us to make the right decisions and live in God's love no matter what we are facing.

Our Parish Homebound Ministry is available to all who cannot come to Mass due to recovery from surgery, acute or chronic illness and advanced age. Eucharistic Ministers visit each week, bring the Parish weekly Bulletin, offer prayers and give Communion. Call the Pastoral Care number above to set up an appointment for a visit.

The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is available by calling the Pastoral Care Office number above or the Main Office number on the front of the Bulletin to set up an appointment for a visit. The homebound can receive this Sacrament every year or when facing surgery, or are preparing to go Home to the Father.

MINISTRY TO THE BEREAVED

Although our journey of bereavement is painful and difficult to bear at times, if we keep a space open, in that same grieving heart, for God's abundant grace, comfort and love, we find a Companion who will accompany us on our walk and sometimes carry us.
