Homeless Solutions is an organization dedicated to providing shelter, services, and supportive housing to the homeless and working poor in Morris County. Clients of Homeless Solutions receive donated items from our Back-to-School Supplies Drive (children living in the shelter with their family) and the Christmas Giving Tree. There are two groups coordinated out of Resurrection that prepare dinner for shelter residents on a Tuesday and a Friday each month. In addition, we collect a donated item that changes monthly, that's listed in the Bulletin at the bottom of this article each week, to help provision the shelter with needed items for clients. Homeless Solutions has a video posted that was posted in 2016 that is worth the watch; the video is about their mission, talking with guests about how transformative working with Homeless Solutions can be. In addition to the shelter, Homeless Solutions owns and operates 57 units across nine sites that provide housing to 130 people

The homebound can receive this Sacrament every year or when facing surgery, or are preparing to go Home to the Father.
