****Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick****

The annual parish-wide celebration of the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick will be held at all Masses the weekend of September 29th at 5PM Mass and the 30th at the 7:30, 9:30 and 11 AM Masses.

Who may receive the Sacrament of Healing?

Individuals who are:

*Advanced in age

* Suffering from a life-threatening illness or chronic disease.

*In preparation for surgery

*Experiencing diseases of addiction

*Those with physical, psychological, emotional or spiritual difficulties.

If a loved one is dying, the **Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick** is celebrated to give comfort and strength to the dying person. It is followed by Communion that becomes for them Viaticum which is food for the journey. The prayers of commendation of the dying to God are said for the spiritual comfort of the one who is dying.
