RITE of CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (RCIA)

Every Christian is called by virtue of our baptism to proclaim the good news. Please consider recommending possible candidates for the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults. Our Inquiry sessions begin at 7:30 pm on Monday Sept 23rd. They are held each Monday evening thereafter at 7:30 pm in Room 10 on the 2nd floor and continue through four weeks after the celebration of Easter. For the months of Sept/Oct/Nov. the sessions will be held at Resurrection Parish. This program is offered jointly with St. Matthew. Beginning in December through the end of March, the joint sessions will be held at St. Matthew, resuming at Resurrection in April until the conclusion of the program. ******Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick******

The annual parish-wide celebration of the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick will be held at all Masses the weekend of September 28th/29th at the 5 PM Mass and the 7:30, 9:30 and 11 AM Masses.

Who may receive the Sacrament of Healing?

Individuals who are:

- *Advanced in age
- *Suffering from a life-threatening illness or chronic disease
- *In preparation for surgery
- *Experiencing diseases of addiction
- *Those with physical, psychological, emotional or spiritual difficulties.

If a loved one is dying, the **Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick** is celebrated to give comfort and strength to the dying person. It is followed by Communion that becomes for them Viaticum which is food for the journey. The prayers of commendation of the dying to God are said for the spiritual comfort of the one who is dying
