****Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick****

The annual parish-wide celebration of the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick will be held at all Masses **NEXT WEEKEND** (5PM Mass, Saturday and the 7:30, 9:30 and 11 AM Masses, Sunday)..

Who should receive the Sacrament of Healing?

Individuals who are:

*Advanced in age

*Suffering from a life-threatening illness or chronic disease

*In preparation for surgery

*Experiencing diseases of addiction

*Those with physical, psychological, emotional+ or spiritual difficulties.

If a loved one is dying, the **Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick** is celebrated to give comfort and strength to the dying person. It is followed by Communion that becomes for them Viaticum which is food for the journey. The prayers of commendation of the dying to God are said for the spiritual comfort of the one who is dying.

MINISTRY TO THE BEREAVED

"We have to be carefully taught". This familiar phrase from South Pacific can easily bring us to Church. Faithfully hearing the Word of God in the classroom, at Mass, and through the Homily, we learn how to live the faith we have been given. Through practice, we begin to celebrate our joys, be fortified in our sorrow and we become people of peace and service. When we pray as Jesus taught us, we practice our faith and increase our knowledge of Him in our lives.
