### **RITE of CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (RCIA)**

Every Christian is called by virtue of our baptism to proclaim the good news. Please consider recommending possible candidates for the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults to prepare for Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist. Our Inquiry sessions began at 7:30 pm on Monday Sept 24<sup>th</sup>. They are held each Monday evening thereafter at 7:30 pm in the Resource Room and continue through four weeks after the celebration of Easter.
