As we await the celebration of Pentecost, we hear Jesus say, "I will not leave you orphans. I will come back to you and your hearts will rejoice". The Holy Spirit is always with us as we face all circumstances in our lives. The love of God, shown to us through Jesus is meant to be shared with family, friends and those we meet every day.
