The collection weekend is scheduled for June 11-12. Please consider using a \$scrip program purchased gift card to make your purchase to do twice the good. See the \$scrip article for more information. Samaritans' volunteers are willing to shop for you if you'd prefer to donate a gift card to be used toward a requested item.

Mothers and children being cared for by the following organizations will be helped with the items collected: Birth Haven, Birthright, Head Start, North Porch, and Partnership for Maternal & Child Health of Northern NJ.

Unwrapped donated items are preferred. Bulk packages of diapers are fine. However, for most other items (formula, lotion, shampoo, etc.) standard sized packages are preferred, as several of the organizations provide clients with a pre-set kit of baby products on a regular schedule for a set period of time. Giant bottles or containers don't work for these programs, as they need multiples of standard products to include in the kits. A bulk package that contains several regular size containers of a product will work. Feel free to reach out to Tammy in the Samaritans' office with any questions.

All items listed on the ornaments must be new. If anyone has any used baby items to donate, contact Tammy in the Samaritans' office, as one of the agencies will accept gently-used items.

**MINISTRY TO THE SICK AND HOMEBOUND**

**“Te Deum:** We confess you, we praise you, and we bless you, God the Father, the unbegotten, God the Son, the Only Begotten, and God the Holy Spirit, the Paraclete, all holy and undivided Trinity”. (Traditional Antiphon). When we start each day with the words and gestures of the sign of the Cross, we are putting ourselves in the Hands of God for our day. The more we do it, the more we participate in His Divine Life and are better able to meet all that comes our way in the course of our day. All life comes from the Father and we are His chosen. All forgiveness comes from the Son and we are redeemed. All guidance comes from the Holy Spirit and we are accompanied.

We encourage the families of the homebound to have their loved ones receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. Forgiveness of sin is part of the Sacrament so that even if they cannot speak, reconciliation is granted. The anointing with the Sacred Oil is a beautiful ritual and gives the recipient the strength to bear their daily difficulties. Call the Pastoral Care Office or the Main Office to schedule a visit.

Grief is a deep and unfamiliar state of being that has more facets than a precious diamond. Bereavement support is the process in which we learn the many ways of working through the maze of emotions that come with grief.
