### MINISTRY TO THE SICK AND HOMEBOUND

The Name of Jesus has incredible power in the face of adversity! He himself gave his Disciples the power to "move mountains" when accompanied by the Name of Jesus. Wheelchair bound folks who are able to be brought to Mass will have Communion brought to them.
