**\*\*\*\*Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick\*\*\*\***

The annual parish-wide celebration of the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick will be held at all Masses the weekend of October 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup>.

**Who may receive the Sacrament of Healing?**

Individuals who are:

\*Advanced in age

\* Suffering from a life-threatening illness or chronic disease

\*In preparation for surgery

\*Experiencing diseases of addiction

\*Those with physical, psychological, emotional or spiritual difficulties

If a loved one is dying, the **Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick** is celebrated to give comfort and strength to the dying person. It is followed by Communion that becomes for them Viaticum which is food for the journey. The prayers of commendation of the dying to God are said for the spiritual comfort of the one who is dying.

**MINISTRY TO THE BEREAVED**

God took care of Jesus. Not as many expected; not even as his Disciples expected. God allowed Him to suffer, to be reviled, to be tortured, yet even on the Cross, there was no separation of Father and Son. The mission of Jesus was to free those who were waiting, in death, for the Savior. As He left the Cross, "It is finished", to His descent into the dead, and then to His Resurrection, He opened the passageway to the glorious Presence of God for all. He promised never to leave us. Those who die in the Lord, live in the Lord, and are among us in the Lord. Can we then picture our loved ones walking with the Lord, watching over us and helping us to walk the road of Bereavement into healing?
